DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Weed Reaper comes pre-mixed in a ready to use 20oz plastic bottle or 1-gallon jug. All the professional has to do is empty the bottle into a four (4) gallon backpack or 100 gallon tank, fill with water and apply

Weed Reaper may be tank mixed with most liquid fertilizer and pesticides; however, a jar compatibility test should be performed on unknown combinations. Apply in sufficient water to ensure thorough coverage. Apply in accordance with best management practices established by your State University or Cooperative Extension Service. Observe any State or Local fertilizer regulations pertaining to fertilizer content, application rates, or timing of application specific to your locale

RECOMMENDED RATES

Apply Weed Reaper over weeds to cover leaf surface thoroughly. **Weed Reaper** contains a blue dye that indicates where the product was applied so that it lessens the possibility of mistaken application or product misuse. All active ingredients in **Weed Reaper** do not translocate significantly and have a low volatility which does not produce damaging airborne vapor-allowing closer safe use of herbicide near desirable plants. **Weed Reaper** is absorbed by the leaves and stems- not the roots, thus product is safe to use near established woody perennials.

PRECAUTIONS

- Avoid getting in eyes or on skin. The use of safety glasses with side shields (or goggles) and water repellent, chemical resistant gloves when handling this product is recommended.
- Do not contaminate food, feed, seed or water supplies during application or when cleaning equipment.
